



In response to the concerns of speeding traffic in the vicinity of Homeway Farm, Meare Parish Council commissioned Somerset Highways to undertake a speed monitoring exercise. You may have noticed the rumble strips at this location for a couple of weeks towards the end of May. The results of this study informed that the majority of vehicles passed through within the statutory speed limits. As the percentage of vehicles travelling faster than the permitted speed limit is low, the Parish Council concluded that no further actions are to be taken.
